- Plans of hosting a READY training for home day care providers in October and February.
- Nathaniel Banks will be working with Bev and Patti to host a meeting for key and influential leaders in the African American community to discuss importance of early childhood and introduce the READY for Kindergarten curriculum and discuss ways in which they could help invite families to workshops.

- The team is working with Parkland ECE on special project for the creation of toolkits for businesses, churches, etc that would educate and support our message in a culturally conscious way.

#### Child Find –

- DSC working on developing and collecting data for Newborn Encounters at Carle using the Baby Talk model. Increasing the number of families at Carle using the program.

#### Que! –

- READY! for Kindergarten team finished the fourth and final workshop for 37 families end of April. We are working towards a collaboration with Carle and Champaign Unit 4 for next year.
- READY! for Kindergarten team will assist CU Early and is reaching out to Crisis Nursery for the home visitation programs using the READY! curriculum. Head Start will be trained this summer on the entire READY! program curriculum and put it in place in their budget for their home visitation program.
- Working on training local home day cares in the Garden Hills/BTW areas on READY! for Kindergarten in the fall of 2017.
