Goal Team: Kindergarten Readiness

QUEL – This group has morphed into a READY! for Kindergarten Team. Plans for reorganizing this group in the next year.

- Continued work with the READY program for home visitors at Head Start, CU Early, and workshops for parents.
 - *Update: Secured funding of \$10,000 through PNC Grant!*
 - *Head Start and CU Early are collaborating to apply for United Way funding and to take over the READY program for 2018/2019.*
 - *Canon Grant (WGRC) request submitted for hosting a READY training for home day care providers February/April 2018. Collaborating with Head Start.*

Child Find- DSC s still leading this group. Amanda has upped her days at Carle from 1 day a week/as needed to FIVE (5) days per week! Preliminary team discussion has begun about approaching Crisis Nursery to assume a similar role at Presence once the OSF Merger advances.

Community Awareness- Lee Ann and Bev met with 2 MSW students through Community Learning Lab to investigate measurement of community awareness work.
