Working definition:

Successful students develop the characteristics and skills needed to:

- **apply themselves toward their vision;**
- **set personal and educational goals;**
- **push through setbacks; and**
- **take pleasure in progress made.**

It is the community's responsibility to provide the students, families and schools access to the resources and opportunities necessary for student academic success.

The team broke into small groups to identify core skills/attributes and discuss methods of gathering input from three target audiences: teachers, parents and students. The team felt the whole group need to meet at least one more time before dividing into subcommittees to work on surveys.
